



Life cycle – Queensland fruit fly

1. Adult female stings fruit



2. Two days later, eggs hatch and larvae develop in fruit.



3. One week later, larvae exit fruit, pupate in the soil and develop inside pupal case.



Egg to adult
2 weeks at 26 deg C

4. One week later, adults emerge and forage for protein, water and sugars.

5. One week later, adults become sexually mature and mate.
